the hope of nations.

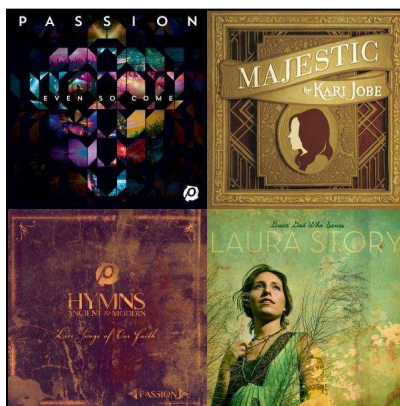
*Savior He can move the mountains, my God is mighty to save,
