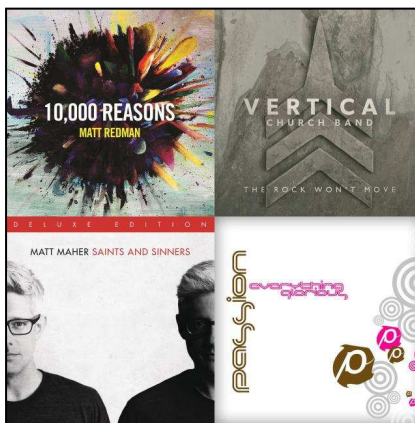
CONFESSING OUR FAITH | WESTMINSTER CONFSSION
