Get up and praise the Lord (3x).

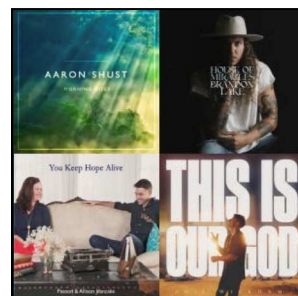
