You call the cynic and the proud, "Come to me now."

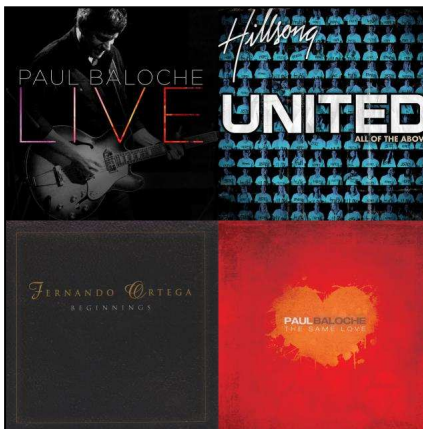
