Getting Started

❖ The theme of Randy's message reminds us of our annual emphasis to be Ambassador's of Christ by praying for three people, befriending two and asking God to give us the opportunity to invite at least one of those three to investigate Christ. As a group discuss how this is going in your life. Pray as a group by name for people who are part of your "three".

Digging Deeper

❖ Read 1 Peter 2:4-8

- A few weeks ago Randy preached on these verses and emphasized the teaching known as "the priesthood of the Believer". How would you summarize this doctrine?
- What phrases in this passage reinforce the idea that "every member is a minister"?
- Randy gave us a memory tool that relates to "offering spiritual sacrifices" (vs.5).
 - o Test your group's memory of these 4 hand motions and their meaning.
 - o Of the four, which concept do you find most evident in your life? Why?
 - o Of the four, which one do you struggle with the most? Why?
- What practical ways do you believe your discipleship group should live out "every member a minister" to one another?
 - An important value at Covenant Church is genuinely caring for one another and the most basic way we experience this care is in our group.
 - Discuss the health of your group in this area. On a grading scale of A+ to F, where would you grade yourself and your group?
 - How can this value and this truth of ministering to one another become an even greater reality in your group?
- * Read 1 Peter 2:9-10. Let's think about and discuss this weekend's message and how it focused on "every member a messenger".
 - What "struck home" with you from the message?
 - Randy talked about there needing to be both the "will and the way" for us to be effective messengers for Christ.
 - What affects a Christian's "will" to communicate the gospel to the Lost?
 - Have you ever/are you now struggling with the "will" aspect of this message?
 Be specific with your struggle as you discuss this in your group.
 - o How would you evaluate "the way"? Do you feel equipped and able to witness to someone who doesn't know Christ?
 - o Have you ever participated in our church's evangelism training?
 - Randy said we all have to find "a way" that resonates with our personality and giftedness, that there are many ways to bring the gospel to someone.
 Discuss the various ways this can play out in a person's life by using your own experiences and situation as a guide.
 - Why should we seek to "proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called us out of darkness into His marvelous light"?

Think About It

Peter's declaration of our 'peoplehood' in Christ has vast consequences for the life of the church of Christ. The church is not just a religious association formed by saved individuals to give united expression to their faith. Rather, the church is more a people than Israel was under the old covenant. Scattered in the world, indeed, as Israel was in dispersion, but a people nonetheless, bound together in the community of those who are united to one another as surely as they are united to their Lord. Church fellowship is not an optional advantage, to be chosen or ignored, like membership in a social club. It is the calling of every Christian. There is a spiritual 'ethnicity' to the church of Christ; Christians are blood relatives, joined by the blood of Jesus Christ.¹
